


2017 LOCAL CONTENT AND SERVICE REPORT TO THE COMMUNITY



Since November 23, 1970, when KNCT was dedicated, our goal has been to serve the residents of Central Texas with educational, entertainment and public affairs programs that are of importance and value to our viewers.



KNCT-TV is a valuable part of the Central Texas area.

KNCT-TV is a non-profit, educational, cultural and informational resource in Central Texas. Each week, more than 60,000 households watch quality programming on 46-1, 46-2, & 46-3.

Being a military community, we provide programming that is beneficial to the soldiers in our area. We also provide quality children's programming to our community.

In 2017, KNCT-TV provided these key local services.

KNCT-TV provides for our community a program called @iYouthChat that deals with issues that affect the teens in our community.With Perspectives and Focus, KNCT-TV provides programming dealing with local issues and how it impacts our culturally diverse community.

On 46-2, we broadcast the 24/7 PBS kids channel that provide the community with all-day educational children's programming.

KNCT-TV'S local services had a deep impact in the Central Texas area.

Each week more than 60,000 households watch 46-1, 46-2, & 46-3. Over 100 school districts have access to KNCT-TV children's programming in their schools.

- 1) KNCT-TV is an important asset to the viewers in Central Texas. Our programming provides information to active duty and retired military, as well as the civilians in our diverse community. Locally produced programs include:
 - A) *Perspectives* is a public affairs and current events program that serves our Hispanic community. The hosts discuss a broad range of topics from Hispanic culture to current events and local issues.
 - B) Focus is a news and current events program that serves our African-American community. The host talks about African-American culture, events and local issues. Focus provides viewers with timely information on upcoming events and holidays.
 - C) Mundo Latino is a Tejano music video show. It is the only place where one can see Tejano music videos from local artists as well as established Latino musicians. The hosts also provide information about upcoming concerts and other Tejano music events in Central Texas and throughout the state.
 - D) Texas Music Cafe showcases music from the Central Texas area. This program features music legends from the State of Texas, as well as up-andcoming stars. The program gives these artists exposure they would not get anywhere else.
 - E) @iYouthChat is a program that discusses topics that concern the youth of today to include bullying, teen pregnancy, and the Internet among the many topics discussed.
 - F) The Bell County Spelling Bee features students from all over Bell County. This program showcases the areas best student spellers and helps students learn to spell. The student to win first place wins \$100 and gets his or her name put on the traveling trophy.

- 2) Programming is not KNCT-TV's only asset. We provided functions that help our community in other areas:
 - A) KNCT-TV is part of Central Texas College. We often host tours of our Television facility for elementary, junior and senior high schools, as well as civic organizations from across our entire broadcast coverage area. Through these tours, students get to tour the campus and learn about classes offered in the Radio and Television department. We offer courses in television and radio broadcasting in conjunction with Central Texas College. Through these courses, students get hands-on experience working in TV production.
 - B) Every year KNCT host's its annual wine tasting event, the KNCT Wine Classic. Vineyards from the Central Texas area are on hand showcasing their wine. Over 400 people from the community showed up to this event. This is a great place for wine lovers to meet, build fellowship, network and learn about wines from around the world.
 - C) KNCT-TV is one of the sponsors The Flavors of Central Texas. This is the Greater Killeen Chamber of Commerce's only major fundraising event. Proceeds from this event help support the Chamber's many programs that benefit the community. The Chamber has a strong relationship with Fort Hood. Our compassionate support of the soldiers and their families has an impact on our community.

KNCT-TV brings @iYouthChat to TV
